Career

- Michael began his professional career in 1987 as a Production Engineer at Waterford Crystal, a manufacturer of high-end luxury crystal.
- In 1990, he joined Iralco, a tier 1 automotive supply company, as a Product Manager and then moved on to become Production Manager at the Irish manufacturing company in 1993.
- Later, in 1995, Michael became Works Manager at Turmec Engineering, a steel fabrication business involved in supply to an OEM manufacturer.
- Michael joined Etex in 1998 as Factory Manager at Tegral Metal Forming in Athy, Ireland, and became Managing Director in 2002.
- Between 2010 and 2016, Michael was Managing Director of Etex's cladding unit, PSE façade. Under his leadership, both the Equitone and Cedral brands were renewed and repositioned in the market and a range of new materials added to the portfolio. Michael's guidance was also essential to the international expansion of our cladding activities from Europe to Eastern Europe, Asia, Latin America and the United States.
- Since 1 March 2016, Michael is Head of the Etex Cladding division, which is now the Exteriors division. In this role, he is a member of Etex's Executive Committee.
